PROCLAMATION

Whereas, communities must come together to provide support to families that suffer the loss of a missing loved one and the victims that crime leaves behind; and

Whereas, every missing person is a child of someone and deserves to be found no matter how long they remain missing or under what circumstances; and

Whereas, families of the missing should be given the opportunity to be educated on search resources, how to aid their investigations of their missing loved one, tools to communicate with their case investigator, maintain public awareness of their missing loved one until a resolution is provided; and

Whereas, Community United Effort, known as CUE Center for Missing Persons, launched the first of its kind safe place for victims to be educated and brought forth in communication with all people who work behind the scenes to investigate, locate and identify those once lost and or missing.
